



Doctors, Hospitals Wage War on Price Transparency

Upfront Medical Estimates Exist In Other Countries, Why Not the United States?

There is a battle over price transparency that is being fought in states throughout the United States. Ohio's Healthcare Price Transparency Law mandates that providers must give patient's a "good faith" estimate of the cost of non-emergency services before they start treatment. The law was originally scheduled to go into effect January 1, 2017, but due to legal challenges from the Ohio Hospital Association and a wide range of providers, the law has never gone into effect.
