Preferred United Plans "Alternative Funding"

Public Health Emergency Ends May 11, 2023

The three year long Public Health Emergency (PHE) will end on May 11, 2023. This will impact coverage for Covid-19 related services for Preferred United Plans "Alternative Funding" employer groups.

Covid-19 Vaccines

There will be no impact to coverage of Covid-19 vaccines. Under the Affordable Care Act, vaccines and boosters are covered as preventative care. This means all plan subject to ACA requirements will continue at 100% coverage, at any in-network provider.

Covid-19 Testing

Over the counter Covid-19 tests are no longer required and as a result will no longer be covered by the plans.

Covid-19 diagnostic screening and related services provided by a licensed healthcare provider will be covered with the applicable plan co-pays, deductible and coinsurance.

Testing coverage for out-of-network providers will follow plan coverage and must be considered medically necessary.

Covid-19 Treatment

Ending of PHE will not impact Covid-19 treatment. Treatment (in-patient and out-patient) will remain covered with the specific applicable plans cost sharing.
